

HONEY EXTRACTING SERVICE

\$40.00 Initial setup fee. Includes 21 frames extracted, medium or deep.

\$1.40 each frame thereafter for mediums size

\$1.50 for deep frames.

The double strainer method is used.

Wax cappings remain, as part of the payment unless negotiated ahead of time.

Please supply buckets for your honey.

Bottling of honey:

\$10.00 per bucket (approx. 40-50lbs). You furnish containers to bottle into.

If you do not supply enough individual containers for bottling, the remaining honey will be stored in your bucket(s) for pickup.

To bottle honey, it must sit for 24 hours for all remaining sediment to rise and be removed. This means a time delay between extracting the honey and bottling it.

I will work diligently to ready your equipment and honey for pickup ASAP.

There is a possibility of comb and/or frame damage in the extractor, especially if they are not wired.

Unwired foundation does not extract as well but does ok at a low speed. Please let me know ahead if you have unwired foundation.

This does not render the frame or foundation unable to use in the hive. The bees will repair the foundation. This seldom occurs, but is a possibility.

We are not responsible for damage to your equipment.
